WHY ARE PEOPLE STRIKING TODAY?

When we retire, we expect to live off our pensions with dignity. The Government wants to force teachers, nurses and other public sector workers to work for longer and receive lower pension payments. There's over **3 million** people striking today - you'll probably know someone who'll be affected.

BUT WILL A STRIKE ACHIEVE ANYTHING?

After rounds of negotiation the Government still won't listen. A strike is one of the few tools that workers have to convince them that these plans are unfair and must be stopped.

WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP?

With your support, we can force the Government to **rethink these plans**:

- Head along to your nearest picket line or rally
- Talk to your friends about the strike. Tell them why you think it's necessary.

WHY DO PUBLIC SECTOR WORKERS DESERVE BETTER PENSIONS THAN THOSE IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR?

It's true that meagre pensions in the private sector are a complete scandal. But this isn't about public vs private. If you work hard, you shouldn't have to worry about a retirement of struggle and poverty - no matter what sector you work in. Opposing these plans will benefit all workers; we all deserve better.

THE COUNTRY IS BANKRUPT. DOESN'T EVERYONE HAVE TO TAKE A PAY CUT?

Public sector workers didn't cause the financial crisis, so they shouldn't be made to pay for it. We all know who caused this financial crisis, so why aren't we creating a tax on the banks?

If the Government really wants to reduce our national debt, why doesn't it:

- Crack down on tax evasion and avoidance - **brings in £70 billion**
- Introduce a Robin Hood Tax on financial transactions - **there's another £20 billion**
